Hello and Happy Pentecost,

Acts 2:1-4 When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2And suddenly from Heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. 3Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. 4All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

Pentecost is a Jewish feast that began with celebrating the Feast of Harvest or the Feast of Weeks and is mentioned in the Old Testament books of Exodus 23, Exodus 24, Leviticus 16, Numbers 28, and Deuteronomy 16. It is also the word used in Christian traditions to give a name to the coming of the Holy Spirit to the Apostles in the above mentioned event.
